Application period closes October 13, 2023

Categories of funding

- Planning (\$250K maximum)
- Implementation (\$4M maximum)

Set Asides

- First Time Awardee (\$250K maximum)
- Habitat Restoration/Adaptation (No maximum)
- Relocation, Managed Retreat and/or Protect-in-Place Coordinator (\$150K maximum)

Planning

- ▶ Development of planning documents
- ▶ Vulnerability assessments
- ▶ Data collection & analysis
- ▶ Monitoring
- ▶ Hosting, or travel to training or workshops
- ▶ Internships
- ▶ Community or youth engagement

Implementation

- ▶ Construction or non-construction activities pre-identified in an existing plan such as:
 - ▶ Integrated resources management plans
 - ▶ Climate adaptation plans
 - ▶ Ecosystem restoration plans
 - ▶ Community-driven relocation, managed retreat, and/or protect-in-place (RMP) plans
