Jens Wickert, physicist, received his PhD degree in geophysics/meteorology in 2002. He joined the German Research Centre for Geosciences GFZ in 1999, where he is research director for the topic “The Atmosphere in Global Change” and responsible for GNSS Remote Sensing. Wickert is also Professor for GNSS Remote Sensing, Navigation and Positioning with the Technische Universität Berlin. He was and is responsible for numerous GNSS related projects with focus on Earth Observation, e.g., GPS radio occultation aboard the German CHAMP satellite or the GEROS-ISS project for GNSS-Reflectometry from ESA. He is author/co-author of more than 250 publications on GNSS Earth Observation. Since 2021 he is member of the GNSS Science Advisory Committee (GSAC) of ESA.
